THE PARTNERSHIP RESALE SHOP

The Resale Shop continued the positive trend that began in the last fiscal year. Due to strong donations resulting in double digit sales increases (24% over last year), The Resale Shop delivered \$28,762 in revenue to The Community Partnership. This was a 28% increase over last year.

The Resale Shop continued to support those in need in the community by providing almost \$11,000

worth of store vouchers in cooperation with other non-profit organizations as well as at the store level. The community showed support of the Shop and The Community Partnership with a high level of volunteer hours and donations. Our relationship with the Rolla Area Sheltered Workshop (RASW) continues to grow as our baling of salvage clothing has increased in volume as well as sale price.

RESALE SHOP GROWTH

Due to the growth The Resale Shop has experienced this fiscal year, The Partnership has made the decision to move the Resale Shop location to larger quarters in a more accessible location. We have moved to Summit Square on 63 North (located behind Big O Tires, between Steak 'n Shake and Lowes). In addition to this much needed relocation; The Partnership purchased a 14 ft moving truck to offer donation pickup of large items. This has allowed us to be competitive with other thrift stores in the area offering this service, as well as self sufficient when transporting salvage clothing to the RASW.

In our 2010 Fiscal Year, some of our results include:

- Total gross sales: \$148,212
- Net revenue: \$28,762
- Volunteer hours at the Shop: 4,705
- 293 vouchers: retail value of \$10,966
